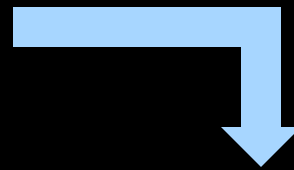

Hubble Telescope being released in orbit

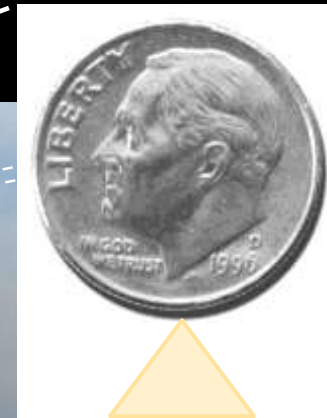
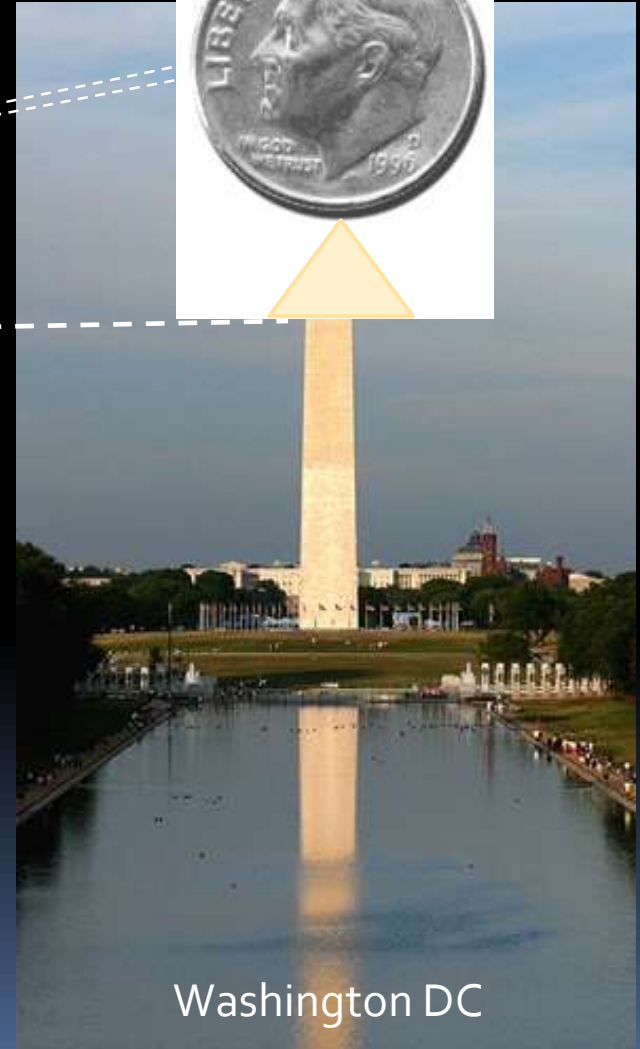


Hubble Telescope

- Orbits earth at 5 miles/sec (18,000 miles/hr)

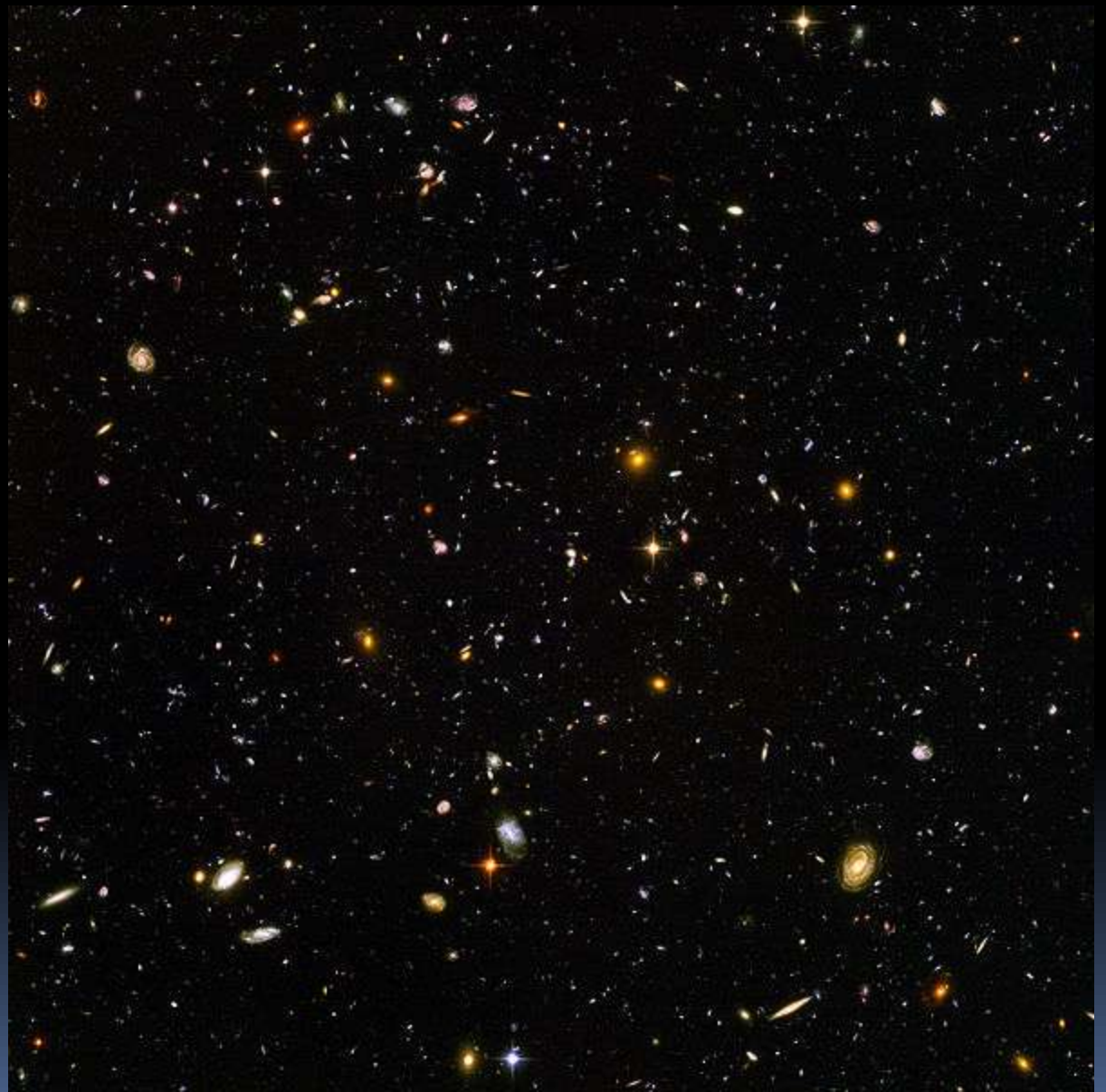


Hubble Telescope Power

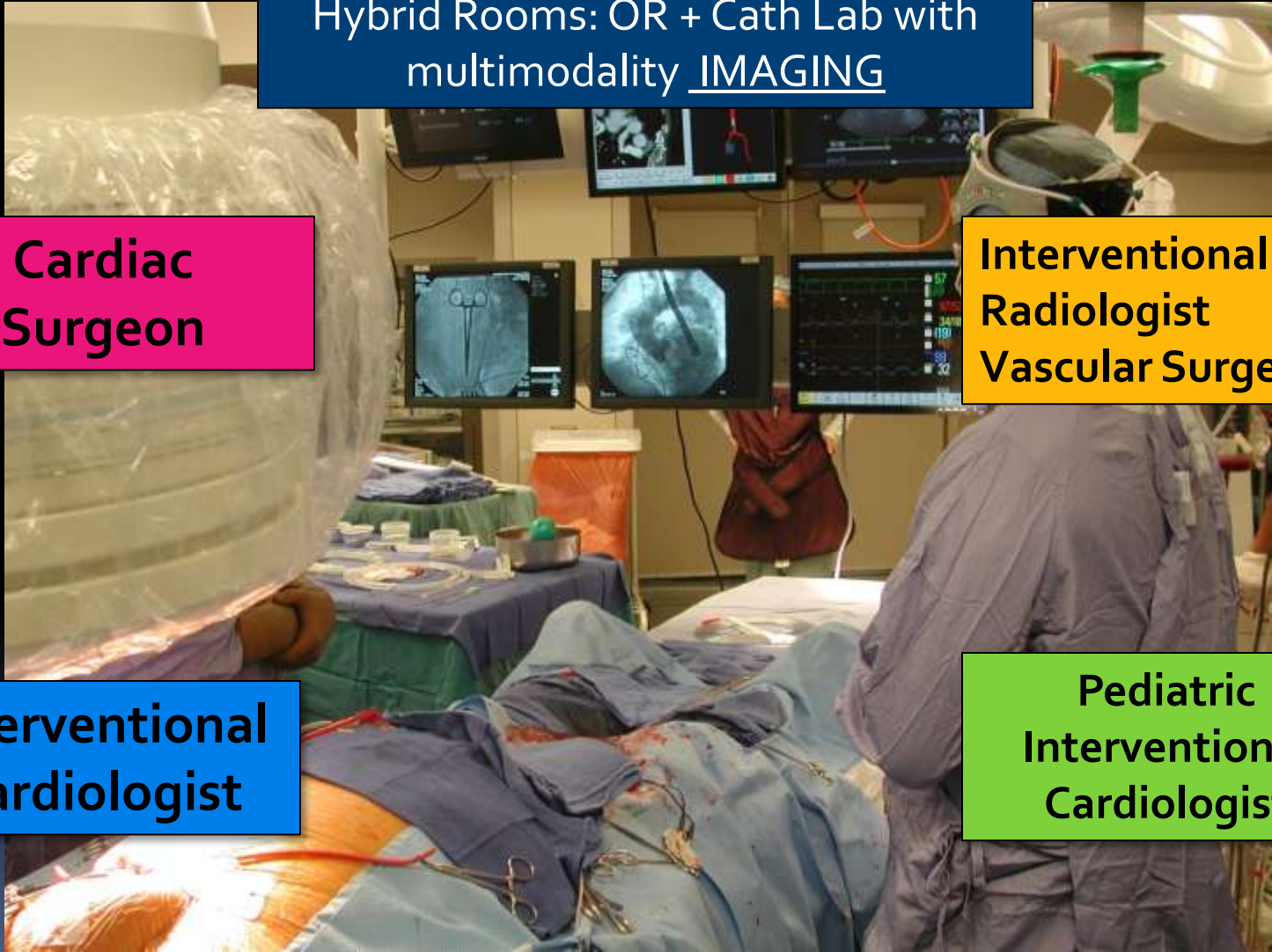

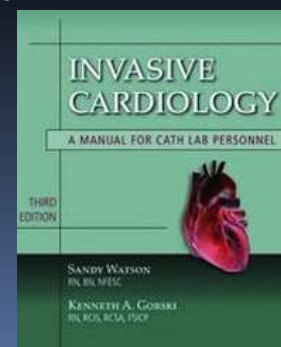

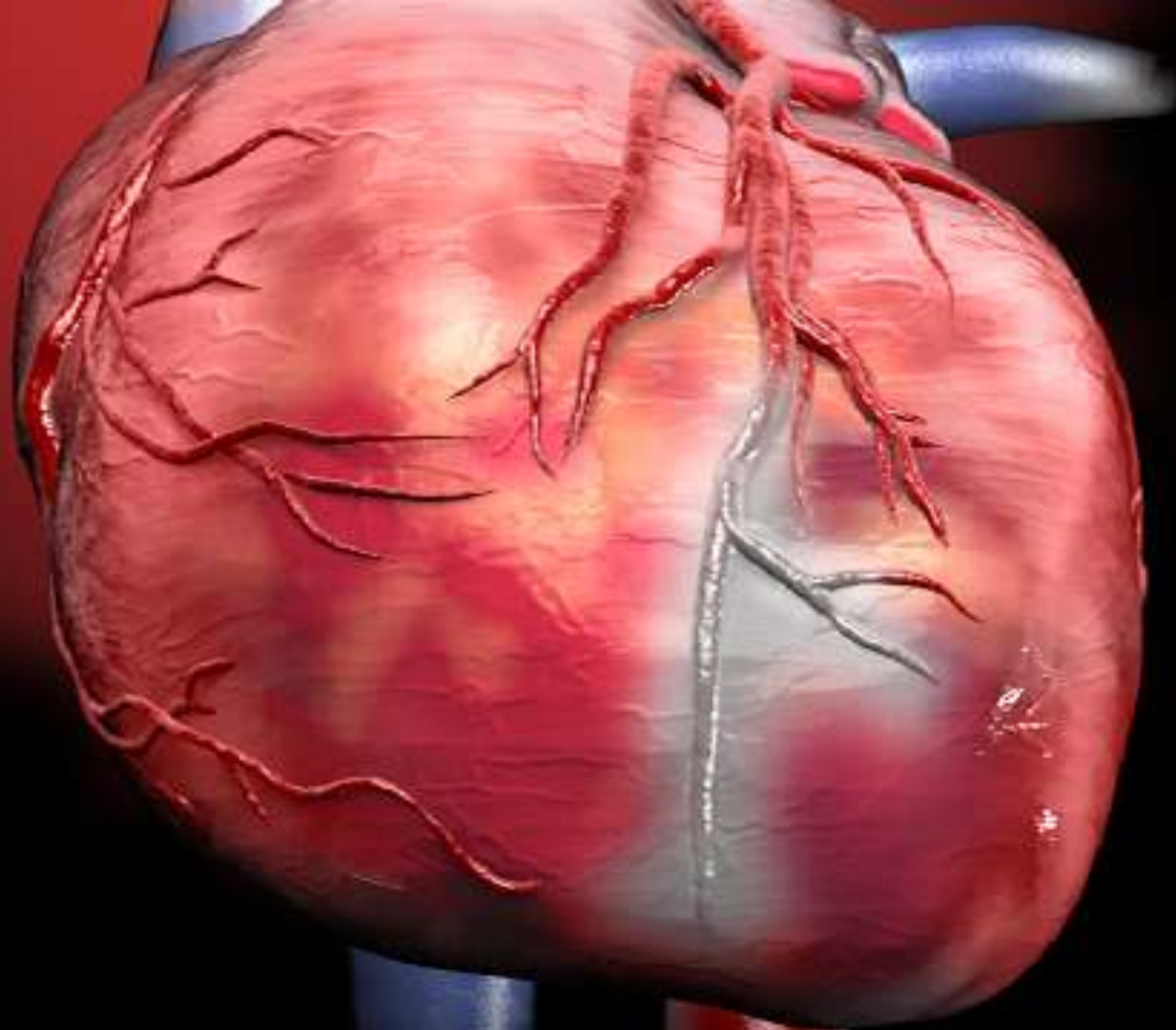
